

Household Hazardous Waste

Regional Collection Center

Items Accepted:

- **Cleaning Products:** bleach, drain cleaners, floor polish, furniture polish, oven cleaners, rug and upholstery cleaners, rust removers, spot removers
- **Fluorescent Light Tubes and Compact Fluorescent Light Bulbs**
- **Automotive Products:** antifreeze, brake fluid, cleaners, degreasers, fuels, motor oil, oil filters, waxes, windshield washer fluid
- **Cooking Oil:** (though not hazardous, this can be re-used)
- **Household Pesticides:** weed killers, bug killers, fungicides
- **Paint:** latex and oil, spray paint, stains
- (Latex paint can be dumped on newspaper and left to dry-then can go in garbage.)
- **Rechargeable batteries of all types**

The following tips will make your visit to the Sac County Household Hazardous Waste Facility more efficient:

- Leave materials in their original containers.
- Be prepared to show your driver's license.
- Be prepared to complete a short questionnaire concerning the products you are bringing to the Collection Center.

- Any unlabeled items will be accepted but an additional questionnaire may be required.



Buy fewer disposable items to save money and resources.



Recycle plastic shopping bags at stores.



Shredded office paper should be bagged separately.



Donate unwanted clothes, toys and household goods to a charitable organization or homeless shelter.



Compost your kitchen and garden waste at home. This could reduce your waste by 25% and fertilize soil in your garden.



Buy products that have less packaging.



When shopping take your own reusable shopping bags.



Reduce, Reuse, Recycle, Rebuy! People are recycling, companies are collecting the materials and making new products from those materials. Buy products made from recycled materials.



 Aluminum	Beverage Cans and Clean Aluminum Foil	No Food Trays, Pie Plates, Folding Chair Frames
 Aseptic Boxes	Milk, Juice and Ice Cream Containers	No Foil Juice Bags
 Newspaper	Newspaper and All Inserts	No Bags or Rubber Bands
 Metal Cans	Food Cans made of Steel or Tin, Aerosol Cans (empty only please), Latex paint cans if dried out.	No Other Metals, paint cans or toxic materials
 Glass	All Food & Beverage Jars and Bottles (Including Colored Glass)	No Mirrors, Window Glass, Plates, Pottery, Ceramics or Light Bulbs

 Paper	Computer and Writing Paper, Paper Beverage Cups, Junk Mail, Brown Paper Grocery Bags, File Folders	No Facial or Toilet Tissue, Paper Towels, Paper Plates, Napkins, Gift Wrap, Diapers, Pet Food Bags, FedEx or Self-sealing Envelopes
 Magazines	All Magazines, Paperback and Telephone Books	No Hardbound Books
 Cardboard Chipboard	Corrugated Cardboard Boxes, Dry Food Boxes such as cereal, cake mix and cracker containers (please remove liner) shoe boxes, pizza boxes (if clean), empty paper towel and toilet tissue tubes	No Packing Material, Bar Soap or Detergent Boxes, Wax / Plastic Liners

 Plastics	All plastic cups and containers #1, 2 & 5, plastic bottles, jugs, jars, yogurt containers, cottage cheese containers, margarine and whipped topping tubs, plastic "Clamshell" food containers and disposable plastic cups	No Plastic Bags*, Motor Oil or Pool Chemical Containers, Toys, Flower Pots, Waste Baskets, Tupperware, or Styrofoam * Clear plastic bags can be used to contain shredded paper.
